

Privacy policy

ERREGIERRE SPA recognizes the importance of the protection of personal data, undertakes to respect the privacy of users, to treat private data with caution and confidentiality and not to use them for purposes other than those specified below.

To this end, this policy describes the methods of management of the site with reference to the processing of the personal data of users who consult it. This information is provided, also pursuant to Article 13 of EU Regulation 679/2016 (hereinafter "GDPR"), to those who interact with the web services of ERREGIERRE SPA accessible electronically on the pages of the website:

This Policy may be modified or updated at any time by ERREGIERRE SPA; therefore, it is recommended to read it periodically.

1. Data Controller

2. Data and purposes of processing

ERREGIERRE SPA informs users of the site that the data collected will be used exclusively for the purposes specified below. The data subject to processing are browsing data and data provided voluntarily by the user.

2.1. Browsing data

The computer systems and software procedures used to operate this website acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols. This information is not collected to be associated with identified data subjects, but by its very nature could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, allow users to be identified.

These systems also collect certain information about your browser session and general data about your device. All data are acquired anonymously and cannot be referred, however, to a specific user.

These data are used for the sole purpose of obtaining anonymous statistical information on the use of the site and to check its correct functioning and are deleted immediately after processing.

Purpose of the processing

These data are used in order to obtain anonymous statistical information on the use of the Site, to check its correct functioning, to improve the quality of the services offered and to optimize the functionality of the Site. Such data shall be processed to the extent strictly necessary and proportionate to ensure the security of the networks and information passing through them.

Legal basis of the processing

The processing is based on the assumption of the lawfulness of the legitimate interest of the Data Controller to manage its website securely (art. 6.1. lett. f) GDPR).

2.2. Data provided voluntarily by the user

The voluntary sending of contact requests through the Contact Forms involves the processing of the User's personal data.

2.2.1. Contact

The Site hosts a CONTACTS section, through which the User can submit requests to ERREGIERRE SPA, selecting one of the following categories:

- Client
- Supplier
- Applicant
- Other

Purpose of the processing

The processing is aimed exclusively at managing and responding to contact requests made by filling in the Forms in the Contact section.

Legal basis of the processing

The processing is based on the assumption of the lawfulness of the execution of pre-contractual measures adopted at the request of the data subject (art. 6.1 letter b) GDPR).

2.2.2. Sending commercial communications

The data provided by filling in the forms referred to in the previous paragraph may be used to send commercial and advertising communications, through newsletters or other mailing list tools.

Purpose of the processing

The processing is aimed exclusively at sending commercial and advertising communications.

Legal basis of the processing

The processing is based on the assumption of the lawfulness of the consent of the data subject (art. 6.1 lett. a) GDPR).

3. Processing methods

The data processing will be carried out, pursuant to art. 4 no. 2) of the GDPR, by means of the following operations: collection, recording, organization, storage, consultation, processing, modification, selection, extraction, comparison, use, interconnection, blocking, communication, cancellation and destruction of data.

The data will be processed both on paper and electronically and/or automatically.

The data, starting from their receipt/updating, will be stored for a period appropriate to the purposes of the processing indicated above. For more information on data retention terms, please write to **info@erregierre.it**

4. Communication and transfer of data

The data, subject to processing, will not be disseminated; instead, for the purposes indicated in this policy, they may be communicated to third parties, including external agencies that support the company in the management of the website, software houses, supervisory bodies, to comply with obligations deriving from the law, regulations, EU legislation or for aspects concerning the management and execution of the legal relationship with you existing or intervening.

The data will be processed by the following subjects:

- Employees of the companies ERREGIERRE SPA, who operate as persons authorised to process data according to the tasks performed and adequately trained.
- External Data Processors pursuant to art. 28 GDPR.

The list of Data Processors is available at the Company's registered office.

For all the purposes indicated in this policy, the data may also be communicated abroad, inside and outside the European Union, in compliance with the rights and guarantees provided for by current legislation, subject to verification that the country in question guarantees an "adequate" level of protection pursuant to the provisions of the GDPR.

5. Rights of the data subject

Any data subject may, at any time, request:

- a) access to your personal data (Art. 15 GDPR);
- b) their rectification in the event of inaccuracy (Art. 16 GDPR);
- c) the deletion of data referable to the same (art. 17 GDPR);
- d) the restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR);
- e) the right to data portability, i.e. to receive the personal data provided in a structured format of common use and readable by an automatic device (art. 20 GDPR);
- f) the right to object to the processing of data where the conditions are met (art. 21 GDPR).

For anything not expressly provided for by the provisions referred to herein, reference is made in full to the legislation in force on privacy, in particular to art. 15, 16, 17, 18, 20 and 21 of the GDPR.

In addition, it is possible for the data subject to lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Authority, pursuant to art. 77 of the GDPR.
